February Update

February 24, 2021-- The 2019 Bond projects continue to move forward with several upgrades being completed and new ones beginning.

The Channelview High School baseball and softball fields are complete and a ribbon cutting ceremony is scheduled in early March. The remainder of the high school athletic facilities are nearing completion. Construction crews have installed plumbing fixtures, stainless steel furniture and a canopy to the new track concession stand.

Construction crews have made significant progress on the new Channelview High School auditorium and continue to place the exterior brick to the facility. The work being done to the Career and Technical Education (CTE) facility is well underway. Glass is being installed to the structure along with exterior brick.

Work has also begun in the new Channelview High School library. Crews have removed the walls and ceiling to begin the renovations. In addition, the new marquee is complete and already displaying the school logo.

“We can’t wait to officially open the new baseball and softball fields. We know our athletes are excited about this and we look forward to having much success on these new fields,” said Superintendent Greg Ollis. “Every new upgrade and change is thanks to our voters, and we remain committed to providing them with updates every step of the way.”

The renovations being made to Alice Johnson Junior High are moving ahead rapidly. The parking lot near the girls’ gym is complete and teachers have already begun parking there. The main parking lot located near the front of the campus is nearing completion and will soon be available for use. Inside the campus, all the lockers have been removed and new wall tile is being installed throughout the school, along with new drinking fountains.
