November 27, 2021--The 2019 Bond project is well underway with several projects already complete.

A community tour was offered to parents, students, staff and community members to allow them to visit the new Career and Technology Education and Fine Arts wing of Channelview High School. There was also a ribbon cutting ceremony with the Channelview ISD Board of Trustees, directors, school principal, and assistant superintendents.

“The event was a true success,” said Channelview ISD Interim Superintendent Dr. Don Beck. “It was wonderful to be able to show off our new facilities to our community. These are exciting times for Channelview. We still have more renovations that are happening throughout the district and I know our community will be proud of the work that is taking place. I remain grateful to our voters for allowing this to happen.”

Construction crews continue to make significant progress to McGhee Elementary. Brick is being installed along with glass windows to the exterior. Inside the campus, crews are adding the framing, which includes window framing and plumbing is being added throughout the facility. The work is on schedule without any major delays.

The maintenance and transportation facility is also undergoing renovations. Crews are currently working on the building’s roof. The bond will allow for a parking lot expansion which is nearing completion. The light pole bases have been installed and the curbs have been added. There are several upgrades that are being done inside the building. An electrician is fixing the wiring for new light fixtures and the restrooms are currently being worked on.
