

April Update

April 21, 2021-- Progress on two campuses and the site of a new campus continue thanks to the 2019 Bond.

The main entrance to Channelview High School is currently being worked on and crews are in the process of installing brick over the main entry. Construction workers added a temporary wall to the main entrance to allow them to work on this portion of the campus. The existing walkway and canopies near the Kolarik 9th Grade Center have also been removed.

Meanwhile, inside the campus, selected restrooms are being worked on by construction crews. Some restrooms are being demolished while new tile and plumbing fixtures have been added to others. The library remains closed while sheet rock and a sprinkler pipe are added.

The CHS athletic track is nearing completion. The track concession stand has been installed along with the ticket window.

Significant progress has been made to the new Career and Technical Education (CTE) facility and Channelview High School auditorium. The sheet rock to the back wall of the stage in the auditorium has been installed. The welding lab has also been painted and work continues throughout these campus structures.

"I'm proud of the work I see being completed thanks to the 2019 bond," said Superintendent Greg Ollis. "Construction is moving ahead quickly and all of our students will benefit from this bond."

Alice Johnson Junior High renovations are moving forward quickly. The front entrance of the campus has several changes, including the addition of concrete to the outdoor seating area. The flag poles, dedication plaques and paving also have been installed, and have given the front entrance a completely new look. In addition, the crews are working on the new roof which includes new exhaust fans.



The new band hall and athletic fields are currently being worked on. The roof drains to the new band hall have been installed. The lines on the new athletic running track were recently painted completing this portion of the project.

Crews are also working inside the Alice Johnson campus with minimal disruption to students. During the Spring Break holiday workers painted the classrooms and corridors. The necessary touch ups will be completed over the Summer Break. The floor was also prepped and new tile was added to the campus floors.

Significant progress has been made to the new Cobb-Schochler Elementary site. Mats have been laid at the entrance of the site for access and much of the site has been cleared. The contractor continues shredding old trees and removing them from the site. In addition, the workers have also added a small office on site and a larger trailer for employees will be added at a later date.
