September 16, 2020--Classes for Channelview ISD are in full swing. All students are attending classes virtually for the next few weeks. The school year looks very different. Fortunately it has not slowed down construction on the 2019 Bond projects.

This month, a lot of progress has been made on the Channelview High School athletic facilities. The softball and baseball batting cages are near completion. The softball field's press box's structure has been completed, along with the chain link fence surrounding the field. Construction crews also began installing the fence that will enclose the baseball field and work continues on the baseball field's press box. In addition, the scoreboard for both fields has been added to the sports complex.

The tennis courts are also nearing completion. The beat board panels and fencing have been installed.

"I look forward to seeing the look on our high school athletes' faces when they see these upgraded facilities," said Assistant Superintendent of Operations Mike Niemeyer. "I'm proud of the work that has been accomplished these last several months."

The expansion of CHS's new Career and Technical Education (CTE) Center and Fine Arts Center is well underway. Construction crews have added the back wall to the house seating area of the new auditorium and it's ready to be poured. Rebar has also been installed and the electricians have begun working on the next phase.
