February 16, 2022--Construction on the new 2019 bond projects continues with many projects complete and the new McGhee Elementary well underway.

The additions and renovations to Channelview High School are complete and students are using the new Career and Technical Education facility and new Performing Arts Center.

"The work that is being done by our construction crews is remarkable," said Channelview ISD Superintendent Dr. Tory C. Hill. "We have beautiful new additions to several of our campuses and our students can take full advantage of these renovations. In addition, construction crews continue to make significant progress to McGhee Elementary. Metal paneling is being installed throughout the exterior of the building and the fencing is being added around the detention pond.

The renovations to Alice Johnson Junior High are also complete. Ashland Boulevard is open and will allow buses an additional entrance to the campus. The canopy sign in the exterior of the building has been installed along with the new marquee.

The maintenance and transportation facility is also undergoing major changes. The restrooms in the facility are being remodeled and new fire alarms have been installed. The work is expected to be completed in the next few months.
