



January Update

January 20, 2021-- The new year brings with it many updates to the 2019 Bond projects.

The final touches are being added to the new Channelview High School athletic facilities. The netting has been installed in the batting cages, and the security fence has been added to enclose the athletic complex. Additional installations include: the light poles, speakers and cameras in the press box, and turf in the bullpens. A ribbon cutting ceremony for the new athletics facilities is scheduled in the next upcoming months, with more information being advertised in a few weeks.

“The new year has been off to a great start and we are excited that one of our first projects is almost complete,” said Superintendent Greg Ollis. “The athletic facility is remarkable and we can’t wait to have our athletes play on the new fields.”

Construction crews have made significant progress on the new Career and Technical Education (CTE) facility. Crews have installed wood blocks to many CTE classroom walls in order to withhold necessary equipment for the culinary classroom or welding lab. Meanwhile, next to the CTE facility, crews are working on the new 1,000 seat auditorium. The theater risers now have a smooth finish and the sprinkler lines have been placed.

Construction at Alice Johnson Junior High continues with the parking lot near the girls’ gym nearing completion and already to a point where teachers can park in certain areas of the lot. The existing driveway located in front of the campus has been removed and the contractor poured a temporary walkway to divert foot traffic around the construction site.
