

## March 2022 Update

*March 23, 2022*--Crews continue their work on the 2019 bond projects at various Channelview ISD facilities.

The renovations to the maintenance and transportation facility are nearing completion. New plumbing has been installed for the new mop sink and the concrete has been poured. In addition, the walls have been painted and ceiling tiles have been replaced and installed.

"It is very important that not only our students have upgraded facilities, but our maintenance and transportation employees deserve facilities that are renovated as well," said Channelview ISD Superintendent Dr. Tory C. Hill. "Our voters have allowed us to completely upgrade our campuses and we remain grateful for their support."

Crews continue to make significant progress to McGhee Elementary. A canopy has been installed outside the campus, and inside the new campus, the floors have been added in several of the restrooms. Construction crews are also installing smoke screens, clocks, pole lights and exterior doors. The library walls have been painted and the casework is being built. In the kitchen, the serving lines have been added along with the overhead doors. Crews have also begun the work on Sheldon Road. The construction has caused traffic delays, but is expected to be completed in the upcoming weeks and drivers should no longer experience major traffic jams.
