

November Update

*November 19, 2020--*There has been substantial progress made this month on the 2019 Bond projects.

The renovations being made to Channelview High School athletics facilities are continuing with the projects nearing completion. The bleachers for the softball and baseball fields have been installed. The softball turf is complete, and the baseball turf has just begun, and the batting cages turf will follow. The concessions stand has had a tremendous amount of work done in the last month, including the addition of the ticket booth windows, plumbing fixtures, countertops and sinks.

Significant progress has been made on the Career and Technical Education (CTE) and Performing Arts Center. The new 1,000 seat auditorium's floor was prepped for concrete and the electrical work has begun. Meanwhile, construction to the new CTE facility continues, which include the installation of metal framing in the new welding and culinary arts labs.

"The work being done is incredible," said Superintendent Greg Ollis. "I know that some of our administrative team has been in to see the work and are amazed by how quickly it is all coming together. I remain grateful to our community for allowing this work to take place."

The replacement campus for Cobb and Schochler Elementary is in the early stages of the design process. A general contractor was also selected and the work is scheduled to go out to bids in January.

"These projects are non-stop, and it's an exciting time for our school district and students," said Assistant Superintendent of Operations Mike Niemeyer. "We know our campus principals are just as eager as our students to take advantage of these much needed upgrades."
