

October 2021 Update

October 20, 2021--The 2019 Bond project continues moving rapidly. Several projects are nearing completion, including Channelview High School.

The community will be invited to attend a tour of the upgrades made to the high school which include the new Career and Technical Education facility, Fine Arts Center and library.

Students have already begun using the Career and Technical Education Center(CTE). Meanwhile, construction crews are putting the final touches on the auditorium. The screens, speakers and seats have been added. It will be complete and ready for the community to see this month.

In addition, crews are adding the final touches to the outside of the campus. Lights, a new walkway, and signage have been added to the campus entrance.

"I am thrilled that we will be opening up the facility for our community to come take a look at these new incredible upgrades" said Channelview ISD Interim Superintendent Dr. Don Beck. "This has all been made possible thanks to our voters, and I want them to know our school district values everything they have done for us."

The maintenance and transportation facility is also undergoing renovations. Crews are working on the parking lot expansion and on upgrading the restrooms inside the facilities.

Significant progress has been made to the new McGhee Elementary site. The contractor has prepped the library floor and installed rebar. The exterior framing is complete and brick is being added to several portions of the campus. Meanwhile, crews are also adding interior framing.
